

**Kitsap PUD’s 2018 Water Utility Connection Charges**

New connections will, generally speaking, pay a Capital Facilities Charge and a Service Installation Charge in order to connect to a Kitsap PUD water system. The charges presented here are standard charges and are posted for general information only. These standard charges can be impacted by Developer’s Extension Agreements, Local Utility District assessments and other special charges. For exact pricing, customers are urged to call and speak with a KPUD representative to discuss connection charges for a specific property.

1”	\$2,225
1.5”	\$3,975*
2”	\$4,525*

*\* Deposit held against and applied to actual time and material costs of service installation.*

**Standard 2017 Connection Charge for a typical residential water service:**

Capital Facilities Charge	\$5,000
5/8” Meter Service Installation Charge	\$2,000
total	\$7,000**

*\*\* Customers on Bainbridge Island are subject to a city of Bainbridge Island utility tax which is currently 6 percent.*

Occasionally, services are installed to properties as part of a Developer’s Extension Agreement or Local Utility District (LUD) process. In cases such as these, Service Installation Charges will not apply but property owners will be responsible for a meter installation. Meter installation charges are:

Meter Size	Installation Charge
5/8”	\$375
1”	\$450
1.5”	\$1,325
2”	\$2,225

Often, connections to infrastructure put in as part of a Developer’s Extension come with “payback” obligations. Developers are typically allowed to collect payback for ten years after installing new distribution main. KPUD calculates payback based on square footage of the lot being served.

Developer’s Extension Payback Charge	\$0.06 per square foot of lot being served
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
